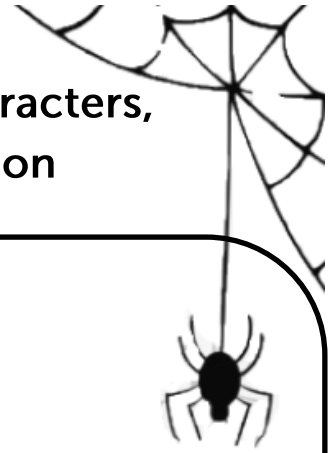

Now that you have your Story, your Set and Characters, it is time to make your Stop Motion Animation



What you will need.

- A Smartphone or Tablet
- A Stop motion app.



We recommend stop motion studio and this is what we will be using to demonstrate how to put all your hard work together. (Be aware that this app has in app purchases)

- You will also need some way of making sure that your smartphone or tablet does not move while making your animation.

Let's get started!

NB. Take your time with this part of the project which will take a while but it will be worth it in the end.

You need to be organised.

Set up your Smartphone or Tablet in front of your scene. It should not move but make sure you have enough room to create around your device.

To balance the phone we are using 3 box files for height. We are using some lego to mark where the phone must be positioned at all times when shooting.

Be aware of where your light source is coming from. Make sure that you don't have any shadows.

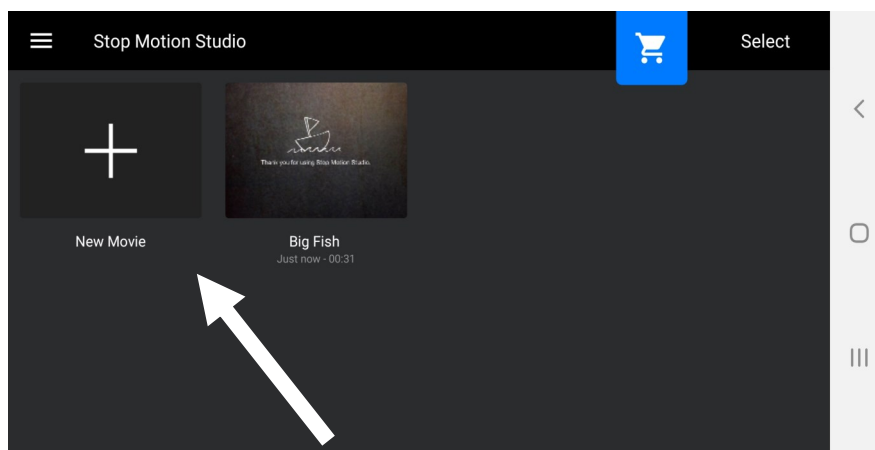


The first thing. What is the name of your production company?

e.g. A (*Your Name*) Production

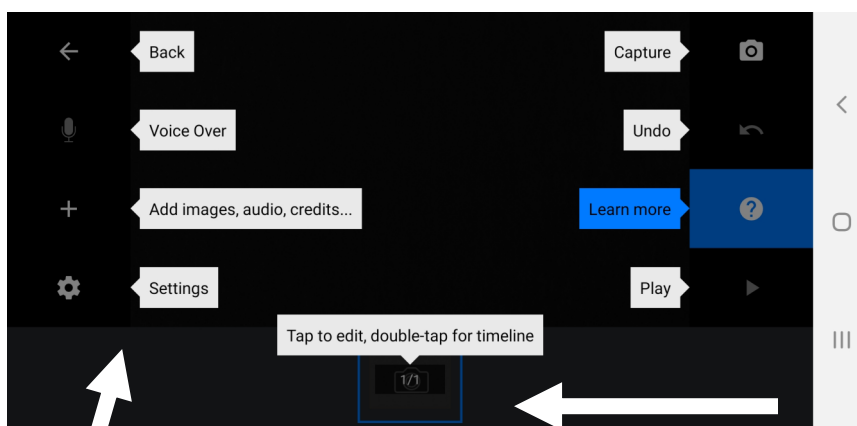
Go to your storyboard. Using the storyboard will help you keep track of how your animation is going. You don't want to mix up the story layout. You don't want to accidentally put your ending at the beginning.

Open the app that you are using. We are using Stop Motion Studio.



Press the + and start

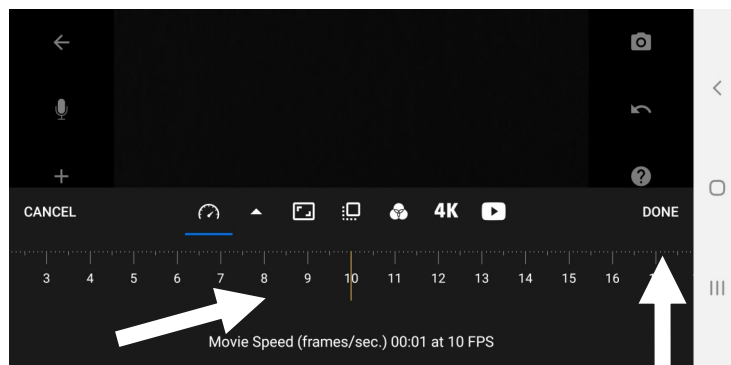
You can play around with the settings.



Settings

Press "tap to edit, double tap for timeline"

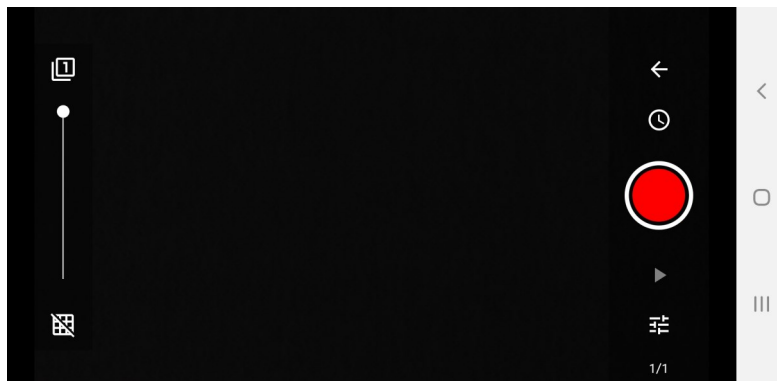
Select 10 images per second. Press Settings to access this. You don't want to have too many for your first movie as it will take longer to make.



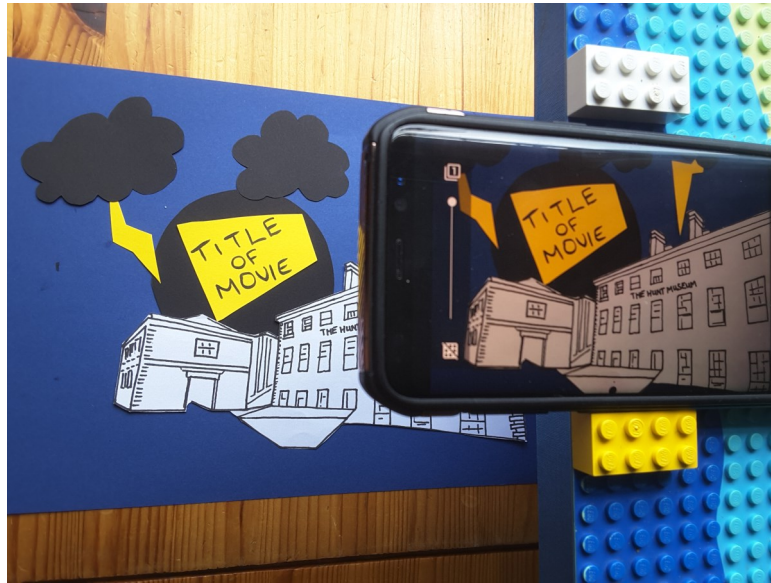
Images per second

Then press Done.

Press Capture and take your first shot (Our first shot is the name of our made up production company)

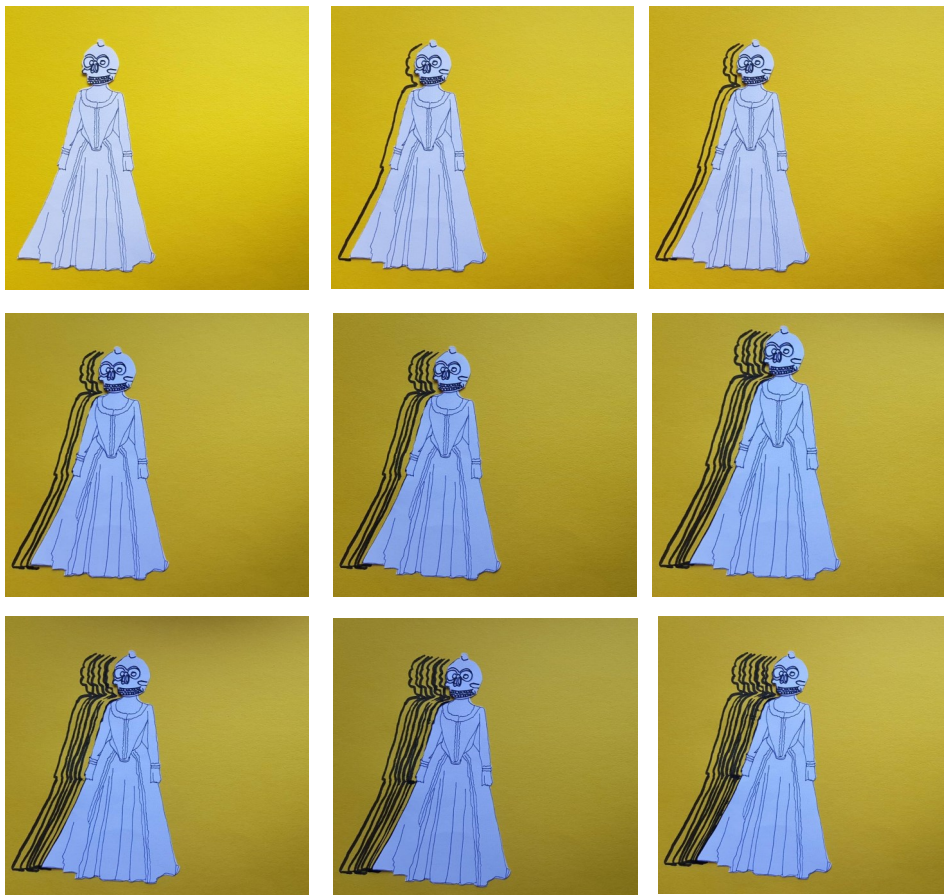


The second shot will be the title of your movie.



Now make your movie. Don't forget to use your storyboard.

To create the stop motion effect, you take the picture, move the pieces slightly, take the next shot and repeat.
