



Getting to the Museum

The Hunt Museum is located 2 to 3 minutes walk from Limerick's City Centre.

We are a 15-minute walk from Limerick's Colbert train and bus station.

The nearest bus stop is at Arthurs's Quay. It is located 3 minutes walk away. From here, The Big Green bus Route 300 services this stop, providing an easy connection for visitors coming from or going to Dublin, Ennis, Bunratty, Adare, Killarney and Tralee.

We are 500m from King John's Castle and 350m from St. Mary's Cathedral.

The Museum offers two parking spaces for visitors with a disability. Call us on 061 312833 for directions and to check availability.

No general parking is available at the Museum. There are multiple public car parks nearby, including:

- Arthur's Quay Shopping Centre car park which has spaces for disabled drivers.
- The Potato Market Car Park. Use the white foot bridge connecting this carpark with the Museum Garden.
